The Spirit of Unity

- The ability to bring together a wide variety of people, churches and other organizations to build houses and establish viable communities is one of the great benefits of Habitat for Humanity.
- You don't have to be Christian, or any faith, to volunteer or to become a homeowner.





Worldwide Need

- 1.6 billion people face poverty housing or homelessness
- 95 million people in the U.S. have housing issues

What About the Children

- 1.5 billion children live in poverty worldwide
- 1 in 6 children in the US live in poverty
- 1 in 50 children in the US are homeless
- Children in poverty have higher rates of birth defects, more often are ill, have lower IQ's and are less likely to go to college.

Redmond Oregon Study on Habitat Homeowners

- 38% fewer trips to the Doctor
- 67% of families reported less conflict in the home
- 63% of children improve their grades
- 75% families report a positive change in their children's behavior.

Accomplishments to Date

- Helped 22 million people meet their affordable housing needs.
- Engaged 1.4 million volunteers in 2018
- Over 2,050 affiliates worldwide
- More than 1,200 in North America
- HFH operates in over 70 countries
- Ranks 21st largest U.S. home builder
- In top 10 most recognized non-profit brands

- 3. Ability to pay




Partner families pay a no-profit, no-interest mortgage

- HFHI Web-based initiative
- Connects willing RV volunteers with host affiliates needing volunteer assistance
- Over 6,000 RVing volunteers registered as RV Care-A-Vanner for more than 200 builds a year.

- Capacity boost to accelerate post-disaster builds




Typical Care-A-Vanner Build






 - Volunteer basis
 - Do whatever is needed
- Opportunity to Learn/teach
- Everyone makes a meaningful contribution



Some Fun Facts

- Average new home size in US 2,324 sq ft
- 3 BR Habitat home is 1,100 sq ft
- 600 pieces of lumber go into a Habitat home
- 40,790 nails go into each habitat home
- 50 gal of Valspar paint for each home
- Foreclosure rate of habitat homes in US is less than 2%
