Red 7/18, 7/22, 7/26 Blue 7/19, 7/23 Green 7/20, 7/24 Yellow 7/21, 7/25

Pumping will begin at 7am and continue until completion. <u>ALL</u> motor homes and trailers: have your compartments unlocked by 7am on your scheduled pumping day.
